

Key Dates

1 November 2021 – window opens for main round year 3 applications

15 January 2022 – window closes for on time applications.

Any application made after this date will be classed as late and processed as late which may affect an offer of place

16 January 2022 – applications made after this date must be made on a 'late' application form

11 February 2022 – last date that changes can be made to online applications

19 April 2022 – National offer day. Notifications of allocated schools will be sent by HCC either by email or letter.

27 April 2022 – late applications received prior to 19 April 2022 will be considered from this date

Admission documentation will be issued by the school for completion with a deadline for return. Your child's place is not accepted until we receive this. It is essential to return this on time and include all essential documentation as advised with the pack; including address evidence if you live in catchment.
