This card is the start of our Greening Campaign in Alverstoke, the aim of which is to help people take action to tackle Climate Change. With your support we will move to Rewilding, Retrofit and other community actions to tackle Climate Change. But first we need you to take action in your home. It's easy to get involved - all you have to do is commit to five of the challenges below, and then display the logo side of this card in your front window by 19 March 2022 and show your support for further community action.

Already doing some of the challenges? Go to the Energy Savings Trust website and pick some different ones. Then put the card up in the window to encourage others!

Turn off lights when leaving a room (non Line or rack dry clothes (or use an

 LED) and stop 25kg of CO2 going into the atmosphere and save £14 a year* <i>C</i>	airer) reduces CO2 emissions by 65kg and saves £35 a year*
Halving your food waste by making a meal plan and using up leftovers will save 312kg of CO2 and saving £252 a year** C	Turn the thermostat down by 1°C and you can stop 325kg of CO2 being emitted, it also saves your household £80 a year*
Boil only the amount of water needed and you can stop 12kg CO2 going into the atmosphere, saving £6 a year off household bills*	Turn off all standbys and inactive appliances and save 60kg of CO2 from going into the atmosphere and £30 a year* C
Replacing all bulbs with LEDs will	Wash laundry at 30° C saving 15kg
